MATERIAL GIRLS present *HELLO GIRLS!*, a curatorial project & performance. From November 10–12, MATERIAL GIRLS will conduct a series of interviews and virtual studio visits with approximately 50 female-identifying artists, curators, writers, and makers, in partnership with the [Virtual Studio Visit Network](#). Visitors to No Vacancy 3 will be able to watch and participate in these exchanges in the MATERIAL GIRLS newsroom, with members of the collective serving as hosts.

The title is derived from the “Hello Girls”— a nickname for female telephone switchboard operators in the early 20th century— whose “soothing, cultured” voices and cheap labor mediated all telecommunications before the advent of customer direct dialing. The exhibition will advance the goals of MATERIAL GIRLS to connect with a broader femme network & generate new dialogues, drawing upon the incurring themes of contact and communication across distance that characterize their non-local collective.
